

Drawstring Carrot Treat Pouch

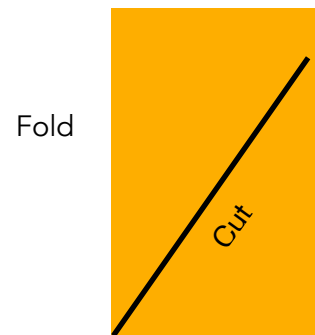
Material needed

2 - 6" x 6" green fabric

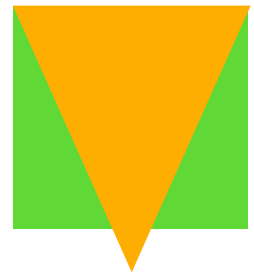
2 - 7" x 6" orange fabric

2 - ?" ribbons or strings

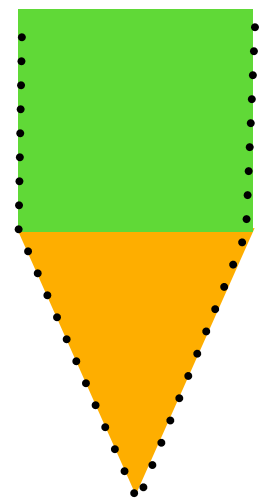
Fold orange fabric in half (along the 7" side) right sides together. Measure down from one side 1" from the top and draw a line toward the folded point to make the triangle shape. Cut the piece of orange along the line. Repeat for the other orange piece.



Place one of your orange pieces on top of the green piece (6" edge right sides together) and sew 1/4" seam allowance. Do the same for the other two pieces.

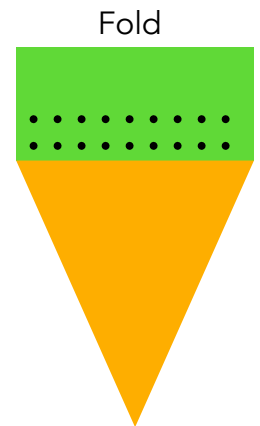


Place the two carrot halves right sides together lining up the green top sides sew 1/4" seam allowance following the shape leaving the top open.



From the top. Fold the green fabric down to edge of the green or previous stitch line.

To create the casing for the draw string: Sew all the way around the carrot at the bottom of the green fabric. Using the edge of the foot as a guide sew a second seam above the first seam. It may be easiest to sew from the inside of the carrot.



Turn carrot bag right side out.

Using a seam ripper carefully open the stitches on the side seam between the casing seams you just sewed.

Cut two ribbons 2" long. Put a safety pin on the end of one ribbon and push it through the casing until it comes out the opposite side. Tie the ends of the ribbon together. Repeat the process for the other side of the casing.
